
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This is with reference to our recent discussions concerning the examination of two botanical materials which are of interest to you.

We would be willing to examine these materials for you in order to determine chemical characteristics and pharmacological and physicological effects of the active materials contained in them. Our usual practice in such cases is to charge for such studies on the basis of our own accounting, plus 105. If such a procedure is acceptable to you, we would propose entering into an agreement which would limit our accounted expenditures to \$10,000 for a period of one year.

When work has progressed to the point where a charge of \$10,000 is approached, we would consider extending the agreement based on the facts available at the time. You may proceed to draw up an agreement on this general basis if you feel that such a procedure is acceptable to you.

So far I have not discussed this matter with any of our staff members pending advice from you concerning the approach which would be permissible.
